



FEEDING THE HUNGRY

The Tri-parish outreach committee is sponsoring the Monday SSJNN meal at St. Paul's on September 30th. This will be the last 5th Monday of the month meal we will sponsor in 2019. The meal will be chili, a lettuce or fruit salad, bread, and desserts. Parishioners from all three parishes are asked to donate a dozen of your favorite type of brownie, "bar", or tea/sweet bread **and/or** a 2-quart container of chili. If we have extra chili it will be stored at St. Paul's and used when they have a last-minute cancellation by the Monday meal cook. Any extra desserts will be used as treats during the week for those children who participate in after school activities at the Neighborhood Network house. Two-quart containers will be provided for the chili when you sign up to assist with the meal. Typed directions, related to making and dropping off the chili and the desserts, will be handed out when you sign up to assist with this meal. We have parishioners from SH and SA who will prepare the meal in the kitchen. The SSJNN already has volunteers to serve the meal. So, help wise, we are OK. Sign-up, for either the chili and the desserts, will follow the masses on the 21st and 22nd of September in the back of each church after mass and drop off will be on the 28th or 29th.

Please cut your bars/bread into an appropriate size remembering that the meal participants are there because they are hungry. Please use a non-returnable container for your dessert. Bars and breads are easier to transport and to serve so please limit your desserts to those requested. No cupcakes or pies please. Tri-parish parishioners are asked to drop off their dessert and/or chili as follows:

- For St. Paul's: Bring your dessert and/or chili to the auditorium on September 28th or 29th. Someone will be available in the auditorium to accept your donation on both Saturday and Sunday for ½ hour **before mass**. Your contact person is Kathie Larussi.
- For St. Andrew's: Bring your dessert and/or chili to the gathering space on September 29th. Someone will be available to accept your donation on Sunday **for ½ hour before mass**. Your contact persons are Kate Fatter and Cele Chadwick.
- For Sacred Heart: Bring your dessert and/or chili to the auditorium on September 28th or 29th. Someone will be available in the auditorium to accept your donation on both Saturday and Sunday for ½ hour **before mass**. Your contact person is Tom Hudson → 864-1615.

If you would like to donate something other than chili or a dessert for the meal the Neighborhood Network meal is always in need of any vegetable in a large #10 size can, a large bottle (64 or 128 ounce) of beverage/juice, 8-ounce **paper** cups (that would be coffee cup size), a bottle of salad dressing (ranch is a favorite), large 10+ inch **heavy duty paper** plates/no plastic please), or plastic utensils.

Thank you to everyone who supports this ministry. Your contributions help to defray the cost of providing these meals for the SSJNN which feeds approximately 100 hungry and immensely grateful adults and children each Monday.
